



Coaching Criteria

Overview:

Coaches include the 7 F's (see below) and are there to help those struggling in those areas to reach their goals and learn how to partner with God in them.

Mission:

Our mission is to disciple others as they learn how to set goals and steward specific areas of their life based on God's Word.

Steward of Faith Values:

Coaches are expected to uphold, practice, and teach these three values as they mentor others:

- Faith – Trusting and expecting God to act
- Excellence – Always trying your best as you walk in love towards others
- Grace – Leaning on God's goodness as our strength and not our own

7 Areas of Focus:

The 7 areas of Focus are based on the 7 main categories that make up a person's life. The goal of the coach/mentor is to help their mentee learn how to set goals in this particular area that create godly habits, and encourage them in times of struggle as they learn how to partner with God in these goals.

Faith:

- Teach others how to grow in their faith and relationship with the Lord.
- Disciple them in how to read the Bible and hear from God.
- Coach them on creating a daily routine in Bible reading, prayer, and worship.

Family

- Mentor others in building a strong marriage.
- Disciple them in how to raise kids that glorify the Lord.
- Coach them through handling family relationships.

Friends

- Mentor others in building a strong godly community.
- Disciple them in how to work through friend conflicts.
- Teach them how to be a good friend like Jesus.



Finances

- Teach others how to manage their finances God's way.
- Mentor them on the significance of generosity and ways they can be generous in their own lives.
- Train them on the importance of giving and being available to God.

Field

- Help others find their purpose.
- Mentor them about the importance of attitude and working their job as if they are working for the Lord.
- Teach about submission and honor within the workforce.

Fitness

- Teach others the importance and benefits of taking care of their bodies and mental health.
- Mentor them through mental health issues and ways to combat these tendencies.
- Help them set goals for their physical and mental health.

Fun

- Teach others the impact entertainment has on a Christians walk with the Lord.
- Show them good, Christian content for the different areas of their lives.
- Mentor them on what a godly, healthy entertainment is like.

Client Relations:

Coaches are in charge of securing disciples to help coach them in their particular area of focus. Sessions include weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly one-on-one coaching calls. Group sessions are also available where the coach(es) will teach a monthly lesson to the group in their area of focus.

3 Levels of Impact:

1. Basic Rate - \$15/mo

a. One-on-One monthly coaching calls

b. Monthly group sessions



2. Standard Rate - \$20/mo

- a. One-on-one bi-weekly coaching calls
- b. Monthly group sessions
- c. 15% off all Stewards of Faith resources, merch, materials

3. Premium Rate - \$25/mo

- a. One-on-one weekly coaching calls
- b. Monthly group sessions
- c. 15% off all Stewards of Faith resources, merch, materials
- d. FREE access to Resource Guide materials, content, etc.

Coaches receive 50% of the profit they gain through mentoring clients. 10% goes to the church/tithe, 40% to Stewards of Faith organization.

Coaching Requirements:

Leadership Development:

Coaches are also required to attend an online monthly leadership session for their upbuilding. Sessions can include guest speakers, topic breakdowns, group practices, tips, advice, and more.

Faith Requirements:

- Received salvation and has been water baptized.
- Attend and be an active member of a local church.
- Actively tithe 10% (or more) to local church, ministries, charities, etc.
- Serve/volunteer in some capacity at your local church, community, charities, ministries, etc.
- Reading of the Word, prayer, and worship consistently throughout the week.
- Attend Morning Prayer (Tuesday Mornings, 6 AM) at least once a month.
- Attend/Watch Monthly Leadership Development classes (turn in notes/feedback from those sessions).
- No partner with evil/willfully hiding a habitual sin.
- Pursuing a holy and consecrated life.
